- The journey begins in the morning at the designated time from the hotel/airport in Rurrenabaque with comfortable cars in a 1.5-hour ride to Santa Rosa. On the way, you will be able to see many species of birds, capybaras and even sloths.
- Arrival at Santa Rosa's port and after lunch, we will travel by river to the Refugio. We will appreciate the typical "sabana" landscape from Beni and other animals like monkeys, turtles, caimans, capybaras and many more! Plenty of chances to take beautiful pictures.
- Arrival at the lodge, enjoy a nice welcome drink and get comfortable in your room.
- Dinner. After dinner, a short "night trip" on a boat waits for us. We will look for nocturnal animals and of course for the shining eyes of the caimans, a very exciting experience.
